

State/Location: (Skip a line)

Who won: Union or Confederate (Skip a line)

Historical Contribution: Give at least one fact about this event that made it famous. This may not repeat any information from the biography or the unusual fact. **Use complete sentences, paragraph format.** (Skip a line)

Unusual Fact: This needs to be an <u>UNUSUAL</u> fact that has not been included in the biography or the historical contribution. This fact can be linked to him/her/it in history or to him or her personally. This needs to be **VERY UNUSUAL** – try to find something I might not already know about your historical figure or your event. **Use complete sentences, paragraph format.** 

Bibliography: Minimum of 3 sources properly noted submitted on a separate sheet of paper. DO NOT PLACE ON THE CARD.
